



Important Information regarding Student Finance for students taking Medical Science (BSc Hons) at St Andrews School of Medicine, followed by direct entry into Year 3 (MBChB) at Manchester Medical School.

Students who intend to take out a Student Loan through Student Finance while studying at Manchester should apply as a **continuing student** for the **6 year course**, **Medicine - Direct Entry (St Andrews)**; you can find this by searching by name, or SLC course code – 705016, you should **choose YEAR 4.** Please note there are 2 courses with the same name – <u>do not</u> choose the 3 year course).

The above course has been specifically set up by the University of Manchester to indicate to Student Finance that this is part of the St Andrews medical programme, is 6 years long and combines a BSc Honours in Medicine from the University of St Andrews (3 years) and a MB ChB on completion of a further 3 years at the Medical School in the University of Manchester, therefore you are a transferring medical student and will continue your studies, completing your degree at The University of Manchester.

It is important when applying for loans that you **do not indicate to Student Finance that you have graduated or gained a qualification** at St Andrews University or your application will be assessed as starting a new programme and therefore you will not be eligible for loans.
