

GUIDANCE ON APPLICATION FOR FUNDING SUPPORT FOR PHASE 2 (YEARS 4-6)

1. Students making applications for funding support to either Scottish Awards Agency or Student Finance England should ensure that they apply using the correct course code and the correct year of entry. Even though students progressing from St Andrews will be completing a 6 Year programme, they enter into the 5 Year Medical programmes at the Partner Medical Schools and are classed as entering into Year 3 (apart from Dundee – see note below) .

- a. Aberdeen. Course Code A100. Year of entry: Year 3 of 5 Year programme.
- b. Dundee. Course Code: A100. Year of entry: Year 3 of 5 Year programme (if completing 3 Years at Dundee after 3 years in St Andrews) OR Year 4 of 5 Year programme (if completing 2 Years at Dundee after 3 years in St Andrews).
- c. Edinburgh. Course Code A100. Year of entry: Year 3 of 5 Year programme
- d. Glasgow. Course Code A100. Year of entry: Year 3 of 5 Year programme.
- e. Manchester. Course Code A106. Year of entry: Year 3 of 5 Year programme.

2. **Applications.** In student's 5th and 6th years of study you may be eligible for a means-tested NHS bursary, non means-tested loan and means-tested supplementary grants (if these apply). Although the Department of Health pays for fees in years 5 and 6, Scottish domiciled students should apply to SAAS for support as they administer the arrangement for the Department of Health. English, Welsh and N. Irish students should apply directly to NHS for bursary support and to local authority for other grants. EU students are only entitled to tuition fee support.
