The 'Student Support Card' system aims to allow reasonable adjustment for students requiring support or adjustments for health problems. These cards have been issued to a very small number of students following assessment and recommendation from an Occupational Health Consultant. The students are fit to study, however they may (on rare occasions) need to be excused from full participation in certain elements of teaching or certain allowances may need to be made.

It is asked that staff accept requests from students who identify themselves as having a card and are requested not to question the student further. The University recognises its obligation to do its utmost to respect confidential information and the privacy of its students.

Any concerns are to be raised directly with the Medical Student Support team.
